- Baking soda
- One spoon

## Homemade modeling clay

Ingredients:

- 300 g of flour
- 380 ml of hot water

- 250 g of salt
- 1 tablespoon of baking soda
- 2 teaspoons of oil
- Food coloring gels or liquids (optional, for coloring the modeling clay)


1- In a small bowl, mix the flour, water, and oil until you get a homogeneous mixture.

2- Add the salt and baking soda. Mix again.

- 3- Pour the mixture into a saucepan and cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until the mixture pulls away from the sides of the pan and becomes thick and paste-like.
- 4- Remove from heat and transfer the clay onto a cutting board or plate. Let it cool for 1 or 2 minutes, then knead the clay vigorously with your hands. Divide the clay into several balls.
- 5- Place each ball into a separate bowl, add a little food coloring to each ball, and knead thoroughly until the color is evenly distributed throughout the clay.
- 6- Store the clay in plastic wrap in the refrigerator to prevent it from hardening. If your clay becomes too thick or hard, leaving it in plastic wrap for an hour will help soften it.


